ISBN:

An ISBN uniquely identifies your book, and facilitates the sale of your book to bookstores (physical and digital) and libraries. Using ISBNs allows you to better manage your book's metadata, and ensure maximum discoverability of your book. Your book is listed in [Bowker Books in Print®](#), which is used by all the major search engines and most bookstores and libraries.

Copyright:

The format is: Copyright (publication year, i.e. 2014) by Author/Publisher.

You can use the symbol © in place of the word "Copyright" if you wish.

Your book is protected by this act alone, but if you wish more official registration you can call the Register of Copyrights at: 202-207-3000 and ask for form TX, and Circular R1, *Copyright Basics*; and R2, *Publications of the Copyright Office*.

Country of Origin:

By law, it is mandatory to add "Printed in Country" (Country = where book is manufactured) on your copyright page for the books to clear US customs. There are no duties on books imported into the USA. If you print the name and address of your publishing company on the back cover of your book, you must also print "Printed in Country" underneath the address. Otherwise, it is not required to print the country of origin on the jacket or jacket flap.

Printer Acknowledgement:

It is customary to add to "Printed in Country" the name of the printer to acknowledge the work performed; which should read::

Printed in Country by Four Colour Print Group, Louisville, Kentucky.

The Library of Congress:

New publishers should go to: <http://www.loc.gov/publish/pcn/> For instructions on how to register for pre-assigned Library of Congress catalog numbers. It is not mandatory to obtain a Library of Congress number and the application can take a month or longer.

CPSIA

Section 103(a) of the CPSIA of 2008 requires that books intended for children 12 and under must carry a tracking label describing: (1) the location of production (2) the date of production and (3) cohort/batch information. Please ask your production manager at Four Colour Print Group for these details which must appear on the copyright page.
